**CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR GIFTING OF
OFFICE PREMISES FOR A PERMANENT OFFICE OF IPS**

As per the resolution unanimously passed at the 42nd General Body meeting held on 11th December 2009 at Kolkata, it is decided to setup a permanent office for the Indian Pharmacological Society.

Main objective of headquarters The permanent office premises is likely to be utilized for collection of all registered documents, list of members, statement of accounts, copy of the journals, regular correspondence with members and various agencies on directions of EC along with streamlining of activities.

Proposals are hereby invited from prospective donors (eligible conditions see below) for establishment of a permanent office of IPS in any metro city in India on/or before 28th February 2010 to the General Secretary of IPS with all supporting documents.

Conditions:

1. The proposals may be submitted by any individual or group of individuals or local branch of IPS.
2. The Donor must register a constructed space of a minimum of 600 sft in an independent portion or flat in any metro city exclusively in the name of IPS or donate a minimum of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees fifteen lakh only) in the name of IPS. [Approximately Rs.10,00,000/- (ten lakh only) may be utilized towards building cost and Rs.5,00,0000/- (Rupees five laksh only) may be utilized towards furnishing of the office, etc.]
3. The Donor must give an undertaking stating that he is the absolute owner and possessor of the property proposed to be donated and that there are no legal encumbrances on it and that he would never withdraw the donation at any point of time in future and would not raise any dispute against IPS with regard to the property donated.
4. The Application must enclose a list of the members of local branch of IPS.
5. If desired by the Donor, IPS will consider incorporating the name of the donor (if he is not a member of the society and if it is not a corporate/industry/organization etc.) in the address of the society. This would not give the Donor any right over the premises donated.
6. The establishment of permanent office will not give any special right or privilege to the local members of IPS to amend the bye-laws of the society at any point of time. The office shall function in accordance with the bye-laws of the society.
7. Time schedule:
 - Last date of application 28th February 2010
 - Screening of the applications 20th March 2010
 - Declaration of results 30th March 2010
 - Registration of headquarters 15th April 2010
 - Proposed inauguration before June end
